

The Aunties Membership Scheme

Fee Schedule

All figures in GBP (£)

From January 2027, fees are calculated as: **day rate x days attending per week x 15.7 weeks per term**. The nursery is open **48 weeks per year** across three equal terms. Fees are charged over 15.7 chargeable weeks per term, which accounts for bank holidays and nursery closure days. Fees are the same every term and will not vary due to bank holidays.

The Standard Term column shows the fee for families without funded hours. The 15hr and 30hr Term columns show the terms fee after OCC government contribution. There are no additional booking or administration charges.

Current Government funding amounts that are contributed to your termly fee are outlined in the table below:

* 30hr funded membership requires attendance of 3 or more days per week. 15hr funded membership requires attendance of 2 or more days per week. For children under two, funded entitlement is accessed through the Working Parents' scheme (available from 9 months); Snowdrop (2-day) members use 15 funded hours.
